Offer Description

Work plan: The advertised scholarship will involve the following tasks:

- Transcription, annotation and analysis of corpus data
- Setting up and running experiments online
- Collection of experimental data via online platforms
- Recruitment and monitoring of participants in online platforms

Grant duration: The grant will have the duration of 6 months, starting in October 2023. The grant contract can be renewed.

Application: Applicants must send an application letter accompanied by the following documents:

- i) *Curriculum Vitae*
- ii) qualifications certificate, diploma and documents proving the titularity of the academic degrees or its respective recognition when obtained in foreign universities
- iii) proof of valid enrolment in a Master course in the scientific areas defined in the admission conditions
- iv) motivation letter including a brief project (max. 3 pages) of the Master dissertation topic
- v) other supporting documents considered relevant

In the case of academic degrees obtained in foreign higher education institutions, it is necessary to present the recognition of the degrees obtained, in accordance with DL 66/2018, of 16 August, or, in the absence of recognition at the time of application, it is necessary to present a declaration under oath that this recognition will be completed before contracting the grant. It is mandatory to present the recognition by the time of contracting the grant.

Benefits

Eligibility criteria

Current enrolment in a Master's degree in Language Sciences/Linguistics.

Selection process

Selection method: The assessment criteria include the following: Assessment of the academic background (60% of the final score) and assessment of the project (40%).

The assessment of the academic background will be based on the CV and the letter of motivation, and consider the following criteria:

- i) academic background in the scientific area of the advertised scholarship,
- ii) experience with research methods in experimental and corpus linguistics.

The assessment of the project will be based on the following criteria:

- iii) research topic of the MA project,
- iv) knowledge of how to use online experimental platforms to collect data,
- v) knowledge of tools for corpus analysis.

Selection jury: The evaluation panel will consist of Professor Doutoras Susana Correia (Chair of panel), Professor Patrick Rebuschat (Panel member; Lancaster University and University of Tübingen), Anabela Rato (Panel member; University of Toronto), Rute Costa (Alternate panel member).

Notification of results: The final results of the evaluation are communicated to the applicants via e-mail, to the e-mail address indicated in the application.

After the provisional list of evaluation results has been communicated, candidates have a period of 10 working days to comment, if they wish, in a prior hearing of interested parties, pursuant to Articles 121 et seq. of the Administrative Procedure Code. The final decision must be taken within a maximum period of 60 working days after the conclusion of the prior hearing of interested parties or the public consultation.

Complaints may be lodged against the final decision within 15 working days or appealed to the highest executive body of the financing entity within 30 working days, both after the respective notification.
